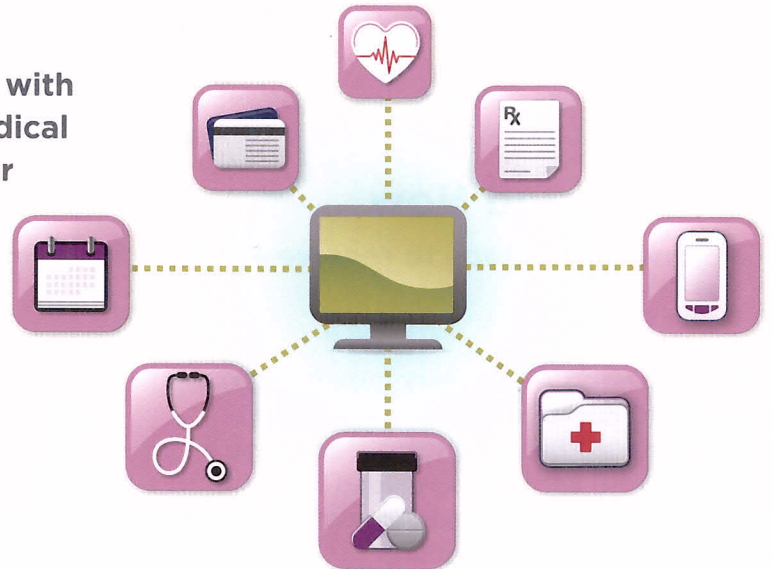
Here's a sample of what you can do on **MyUPMC**:

MyUPMC Proxy

What is Proxy?

The **Proxy** feature from MyUPMC allows adult patients to give family members or other designated individuals access to their MyUPMC account, which includes UPMC HealthTrak features and UPMC AnywhereCare online visits. On the patient's behalf, the proxy can access most MyUPMC features. A proxy representative does not have to be a UPMC patient.

Pediatric Proxy is available for parents/legal guardians from the birth of their child until the child's 18th birthday. Pediatric proxy allows parents/legal guardians to request primary care doctor's appointments, communicate with their child's doctor, and view immunizations. It also allows them to conduct a UPMC AnywhereCare visit with their child, ages 3 to 18.

Get Started Now

Follow these steps to receive **Adult or Pediatric Proxy** access.

Adult Proxy

1. Request an Adult Proxy form from your UPMC doctor's office or the patient's doctor's office, or if you already have a MyUPMC account, download the form under "Request Proxy Access" within the UPMC HealthTrak section.
2. Submit the signed form to the patient's doctor's office or mail/fax it to the address indicated on the first page of the form.
3. If you don't have a MyUPMC account, create an account by:
 - Requesting an activation code from your UPMC doctor's office or the patient's doctor's office
 - Or by signing up online at MyUPMC.com.
(Note: The patient does not need to have a MyUPMC account to designate a proxy; however, the individual who is designated as a proxy must obtain their own MyUPMC account to access the proxy feature.)
4. Once your MyUPMC account is created, log in to access UPMC HealthTrak. Click "My Family's Records." You can now access the health information of the family member or other individual who gave you proxy access.

Pediatric Proxy

For MyUPMC Members

1. Complete the online Pediatric Proxy request form under "My Family's Records" within UPMC HealthTrak.
(Note: this feature is only available for Pediatric Proxy requests.)
2. Once the request has been processed and approved, you will be granted Pediatric Proxy access.

For Non-MyUPMC Members

If you are not a MyUPMC member, you can still request Pediatric Proxy access. Simply request a Pediatric Proxy form from your doctor's office and follow Adult Proxy steps two through four to obtain Proxy access.

Note on Pediatric Proxy:

It takes one business day from the time the Pediatric Proxy request is received until the Proxy is able to conduct a UPMC AnywhereCare visit with the child. The one business day time frame is contingent upon all required documentation being valid.
